Reference letters are required. Letters may be from school administrators, teachers, civic leaders, clergy or neighbors. Please limit to three references. Letters may not be submitted from relatives.

The Scholastic Information Form must be completed by your guidance counselor or other appropriate school official. You must submit this form along with your application, financial information form, transcript of grades and essay to: Choptank Electric Trust Scholarship, Attn: Anne Whaples, P.O. Box 426, Denton MD 21629, by the deadline.

Finalists may be required to provide additional information as deemed necessary by the judges.

Application and essay deadline is March 30, 2012.

Be sure to include all required forms; Incomplete applications will not be considered.
